Product Group: Software; Microlog Analyzer Product: CMSW7311 – Analysis and Reporting Manager; CMXA70 Microlog GX Version: ARM software v2.0; GX firmware v2.03

Abstract

The message "Error loading module P2P.dll" is displayed when attempting to upload non-route data from a Microlog GX70 into SKF Analysis and Reporting Manager (stand-alone version) software. This article discusses the issue and also provides a workaround.

Overview

The "P2P.dll" is used by SKF Analysis and Reporting Manager (ARM) to unload non-route data. It was removed in v2.0 because in Microlog firmware v4, the "Non-Route" module was incorporated into the "Analyzer" module and so therefore non-route data is unloaded as Analyzer module files. This turns out to be unfortunate for users who still run older versions of the Microlog.

To work around the issue, perform the following steps:

- 1. Save the file labeled "P2P.dll" located under the Attachments section to the right. [Figure 1]

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2. Place the file in the Analysis and Reporting Manager folder. In Windows 7, the default directory would be:

C:\Program Files (x86)\SKF-RS\Analysis and Reporting Manager

3. Perform the upload again. The error will no longer be seen.
